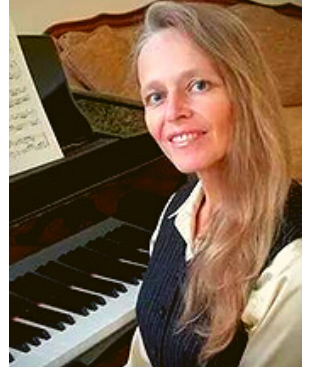
THE INTERSECTION OF ENERGY & ART

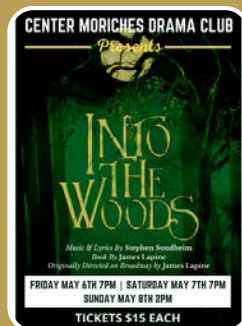
