**Project**: Gaugin was known for his primitive landscapes. He painted where he lived and it was beautiful. We live in a beautiful part of the world and we have fabulous sunsets. Grab one of your photographs or use your imagination and create your sunset into a stunning drawing using bright oil pastels.

**Process**: Find a beautiful picture of a sunset and create a landscape using his primitive style and bright palette. Sketch out the picture first, foreground, middle ground, and background. Then draw it in a thick black line and color it in with bright colors. You can use oil pastels, I like working in layers see if this works for you. Gaugin used a lot of black to outline and emphasize. Have fun!

**Materials**: You will need paper, any color, a black marker, and a bright medium, pastels, crayons, markers or paint will all work.
