

Wassily Kandinsky

Project: Our project will include understanding contrasting colors and how they work together, using Kandinsky's painting, Concentric Circles as an inspiration.

Process: Draw a line in the center of your paper vertically and horizontally, making four squares. Draw a large circle the same size in each square. Draw two more circles in each circle. Color each ring with contrasting colors, red/green, yellow/purple, or blue/orange, alternating the colors. Then color the boxes.

Materials: Paper and any color medium, paint, marker, or pastel.
